

Bylaws/ Mission- Our goal is to inform and instruct the public with an authentic, accurate impression of period military engineering in an enjoyable and family friendly atmosphere.

No fees are assessed for participation at this time but may be at a later date if approved by the majority of the members.

All members of the unit will actively participate in completing the tasks necessary for the unit to accomplish its mission. These may include, but are not limited to camp set up, maintenance and tear down, reenactment participation, living history instruction, drill, cooking etc.

Tasks will be assigned by the ranking persons present with every effort made to share duties equally and according to rank. All members will actively participate in instructing the public and make themselves available in camp to do so at the discretion of the commander present

Camps will be highly maintained in a clean, efficient and military manner at all times.

While alcohol may be consumed by persons only of legal age, at no time is intoxication acceptable. Alcohol will be consumed only after public hours are completed.

Once a member has signed up to participate in an event with this company, they are to remain with the company and are prohibited from participating with another unit for the duration of that event.

There will be no public displays of affection in camp. Language and actions will be maintained with a respect to public decency at all times. Members of the US Engineer Bn. Co. A will carry out the impression in a professional and appropriate manner at all times.

No members under the age of 16 are permitted to carry or fire a working musket as per NY State Law. They may carry non-firing weapons in parade formations and ceremonies.

All new members will be evaluated by NCOs and/or officers to establish their familiarity with safety procedures regarding rifle use, edged weapon safety and camp safety. No new member will be allowed to participate in a reenactment without approval of an NCO or officer performing this evaluation.

Amendments to these bylaws require the approval of the majority of the unit after open discussion and vote. Only full members may vote on unit decisions.

Membership- All persons willing to accurately portray a role in the unit are welcome without discrimination due to age, race, sexual orientation, religion etc. All members will portray a soldier participant in the unit. All persons wishing to become a member of the US Engineer Bn. Co. A will complete an application. Completed applications will be reviewed by the officers and NCOs of the unit and either approved or disapproved. Approved applicants will be considered as recruits until participating in two events. At that time their applications and participation will be reviewed again and their membership status be voted upon by the members of the unit. If approved, applicants are considered full members of the unit. Children of the ages 10-16, with participating parent or guardian, may be voted into the company as non-voting cadets. Children must serve in a field function such as runner, musician, field aid etc.
